

Softex Web Hosting Solutions – Help Center

A full backup will create a zip file of your account that includes all of your files, databases, email forwarders, and any emails stored on the server. Once the full backup is created in cPanel, you can then download the backup to your computer.

Generating the one backup file may take longer, but it ensures you have a copy of everything in your account. While this may sound great, if your website is fairly large, downloading these backups on a regular basis takes a lot of time and can take up a lot of disk space.

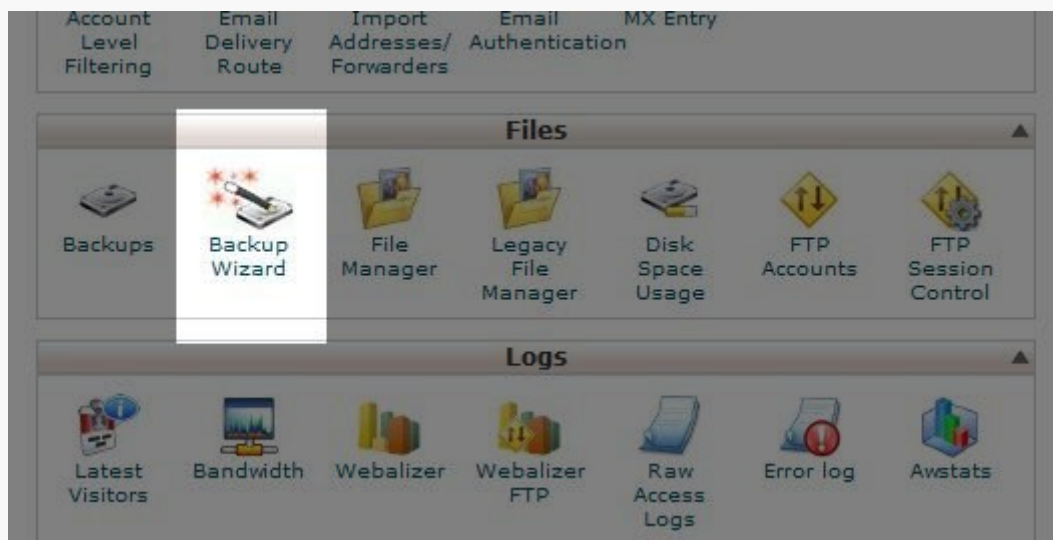
VERY IMPORTANT

You also need to make sure that there is enough hosting space on your hosting account before making backup , if you your website is using 400 MB then you will need at least other 400 MB of free space within your hosting plan , to save the backup file on it.


Backup files are saved within your hosting plan, so it is critical you delete it from file manager, after you download it.

Steps to create Backup from your website


1. You need to log into your Cpanel account and click on the Backup Wizard under the Files sub-header:



2. Next, click on **Backup**:

This feature allows you to restore parts of your cPanel by uploading your partial backup zip file(s) that you downloaded from the backup feature.

The following can be restored:

- Home Directory
- MySQL Databases
- Email forwarders configuration
- Email filters configuration


